MISSION TO LIBERIA BY DR. PHILIP TOGUN

We left for Liberia on Tuesday May 20, 2025 and arrived in Gbarnga, Liberia on Thursday May 22, 2025. On Friday May 23, we ministered at Gbarnga Prison to a large number of prisoners who enthusiastically welcomed us. Our daughter, Dr. Sola Togun-Butler spoke on how to take care of one's mental health while Pastor Philip Togun preached on the topic, "A New Beginning". Ten people accepted Christ and were given Bibles. They will be followed up by Pastor Moses Myakpan. On Saturday May 24th, the medical outreach took place. The outreach was preceded by a short exhortation by Pastor Kikelomo Togun. An invitation to accept Christ yielded twenty responses. They were given Bibles. The outreach, led by Dr. S. Meleseh Kargban Sr, lasted all day and two hundred and fifty patients were seen. We would like to express our gratitude to the medical staff and other volunteers for making the medical outreach a success.

On Sunday May 25th, we worshipped at Christlove church branch in Gbarnga. Pastor Kikelomo Togun preached. Ten people gave their lives to Christ. At the service the three of us were each presented with Liberian attire. We would like to express our appreciation to Pastor Moses Myakpan and the entire church for their dedication to the cause of Christ.

We left Gbarnga on Monday May 26 and arrived in Shreveport on Wednesday May 28. We thank God for journey mercies and a successful mission trip.

INTEGRITY IN THE CHURCH BY PASTOR KIKELOMO TOGUN

What is integrity? It means moral uprightness, it means honesty. This is a topic that is very important in ministry today. <u>2 Corinthians 1:18-20 states, "But</u> <u>as God is true, our word toward you was</u> <u>not yea and nay. For all the promises of</u> <u>God in Him are yea and in Him, Amen".</u>

Paul is saying here that God is true and it is not yea and nay but yea. There are many Christians today whose stand is difficult to know through what they say.

We all know that integrity is lacking in many of our churches all over the world. We have been disappointed with some of our overseas partners. God is a God of integrity; He does not lie and His promises are yea and amen. God wants His ministers and children to be like Him – men and women of integrity. The scripture says God can be trusted; He does not lie and you can take His word to the bank. Knowing that God is a God of integrity, we His ministers and children should strive to be men and women of integrity.

Matthew 5:37 states: "So let your word be yes and yes, no be no for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil". It says mean what you say and say what you mean. So a man of integrity will not lie, falsify records, give a false report and will not make fake promises. The lack of integrity in our churches today affects pastors and congregations. It has been normalized such that it does not seem to bother a lot of professing Christians!

We need to realize that we will give account to God on that day. We are accountable to God for everything we do or say. He is going to separate the sheep from the goats and utter those terrible words: "Depart from Me you workers of iniquity". Lack of integrity is due to lack of fear of God in the church and the pulpit. *Romans 14:12 states: "So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God"* Every one, not just the pastors but everyone of us.
